## FS-ISAC And BITS Launch Trusted Email Registry

The FS-ISAC and BITS, the technology policy division of The Financial Services Roundtable, announced the launch of the Trusted Email Registry, a new service that facilitates a financial institution's ability to prevent email fraud and phishing attacks through enhanced threat intelligence. FS-ISAC and BITS have partnered with Return Path and Agari to provide the real-time email data and analysis financial institutions can rely on to deepen monitoring of email traffic. The Registry will collect information about email traffic from Internet Service Providers (ISPs) and make domain-specific reports available to financial institutions, providing deeper insight into attempts to send fraudulent emails purporting to originate from the financial institution's system.

The service is available at no cost to your firm as an FS-ISAC member. You can choose Agari or Return Path, both industry leaders in email authentication deployment and data analysis, to facilitate the information retrieval. For more information go to [www.fsisac.com](http://www.fsisac.com).
