## Two Big Exercises Coming Soon

The FS-ISAC will be participating in two big exercises, the National Level Exercise 12 (NLE-12) and the Resilient Constellation Exercise Series (RCES). NLE-12 will consist of four cyber related exercises beginning in the first quarter of this year. The first two exercises will focus on the cyber centers and the FS-ISAC will be engaged through its role on the floor of the National Cybersecurity and Communications Integration Center (NCCIC) as well as the Cyber Unified Coordination Group (Cyber-UCG). The third exercise, referred to as the Capstone Event, will involve broader participation and will be a 3-day exercise involving cyber and physical consequences. The final exercise will be primarily a government continuity of operations (COOP) exercise but there will be some limited FS-ISAC play via the NCCIC and/or National Infrastructure Coordinating Center (NICC). FS-ISAC will be setting up an exercise tab in the FS-ISAC secure portal as it has done in previous exercises and will be disseminating exercise constructs as they come in. Companies can choose to engage directly in the exercise, or play through the FS-ISAC. Please look for more NLE-12 information as details arise.

RCES is an exercise designed to support critical infrastructure preparedness primarily through evaluating information sharing processes. The scenario will center on a physical overseas threat that will eventually find its way to the U.S. critical infrastructure. The exercise will consist of primarily nine-ten exercises over the last half of 2012 and the first quarter of 2013. It will involve both national and regional elements. Regions being looked at are Atlanta, Houston and Southern Virginia. Again, please look for more RCES information in the near future.
