Not Too Late To Sign Up For CAPP Exercise

Over a three day period this fall, in conjunction with FS-ISAC, the Payments Risk Council is conducting a simulated attack on payment processes to help you gauge your financial institution's readiness in the event of such an attack or event. Participants in The Cyber Attack Against Payments Processes (CAPP) exercise can choose between two three-day periods - **November 7-9, 2012** and **November 13-15, 2012**. Registration is free and is open to any financial institution that sends or receives ACH transactions, checks or wires, any financial institution that utilizes online banking for their customers or members and any bank or credit union that issues check cards. A similar exercise was conducted in November 2011 that helped the industry identify ways to prevent, detect and respond to cyber attacks against payment processes. The deadline to register for the November 7-9 period is **11/05/12** and for the November 13-15 period is **11/09/12**.
