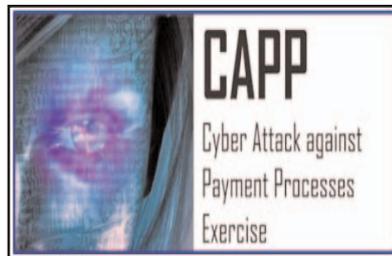
Regional Workshops Offer Great Opportunity
